Review Report on Unaudited Financial Results**To the Board of Directors of Chaitanya India Fin Credit Private Limited**

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Chaitanya India Fin Credit Private Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and nine months period ended 31 December 2025 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 'Interim Financial Reporting' ('Ind AS 34'), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with relevant rules issued thereunder, the circulars, guidelines and directions issued by the Reserve Bank of India ('RBI guidelines'), other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 52 of the Listing Regulations. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
4. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Ind AS, RBI Guidelines and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 52 of the Listing Regulations, 2015, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement or that it has not been prepared in accordance with the relevant prudential norms issued by the Reserve Bank of India in respect of income recognition, asset classification, provisioning and other related matters.

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- 1 The above unaudited financial results of Chaitanya India Fin Credit Private Limited ('the Company') have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on February 03, 2026.
- 2 The unaudited financial results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ("IndAS") notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 ("the Act") read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standard) Rules, 2015 as amended and in compliance with regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- 3 The Rated, Listed, Secured Non convertible Debentures amounting to ₹ 833.33 Lakhs are secured by way of first and exclusive charge on specified pool of receivables on respective NCDs is maintained with minimum asset coverage ratio of 100% for NCDs.
- 4 Information as required by Regulation 52(4) of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation 2015 is attached as **Annexure 1**.
- 5 The Company operates in a single reportable segment, i.e., financing, which is considered to have similar risks and returns in accordance with Ind AS 108 – Operating Segments, specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act"). The Company also operates in a single geographical segment, i.e., within India. Further, the Company is not reliant on revenue from any single external customer.
- 6 Disclosures pursuant to Non-Banking Financial Companies - Transfer and Distribution of Credit Risk Directions, 2025 and Reserve Bank of India (Non-Banking Financial Companies - Financial Statements: Presentation and Disclosures) Directions, 2025 dated November 28, 2025 are given below:

- 7 Details of transfer through Co-lending akin to Direct Assignment in respect of loans not in default during the Nine months period ended December 31, 2025: Nil

- 8 The Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on November 06, 2024 have inter-alia, considered and approved the draft Scheme of Amalgamation ("Scheme") between Svatanttra Holdings Private Limited ('First Transferor Company'), Chaitanya India Fin Credit Private Limited ('Second Transferor Company') and Svatanttra Microfin Private Limited ('Transferee Company) and their respective shareholders under sections 230 to 232 read with Section 66 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. The Scheme is subject to the receipt of necessary approvals from the statutory and regulatory authorities including the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Competition Commission of India (CCI), Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), BSE Limited and the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT), Mumbai Bench and such other approvals, permission and sanctions, as may be necessary.

The BSE Limited vide its letter dated February 6, 2025, bearing number DCS/AMAL/TS/REG59A/3514/2024-25 has issued Observation Letter with 'no adverse observations on the Scheme of Amalgamation. The first motion application was heard by the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai Bench on May 06, 2025 and the Order, seeking directions for holding meetings of the Debenture holders for obtaining their approval for the proposed Scheme of Amalgamation, was pronounced on June 10, 2025.

Pursuant the direction of the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai Bench dated 10th June 2025, meetings of the Debenture holders were convened on 19th August 2025, and the requisite approval were obtained from them.

The Company has filed the petition with the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai Bench, on 23rd September 2025. The final hearing was heard on 3 February 2026 and the matter is reserved for order. The Company is awaiting the final pronouncement.

- 9 On November 21, 2025, the Government of India has notified the four Labour Codes - the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (collectively referred to as New Labour Codes) - consolidating 29 existing labour laws. As per the requirements under Ind AS 19, changes to employee benefit plans arising from the New Labour Codes constitute plan amendments and are required to be treated as past service costs in the Statement of Profit and Loss. Accordingly, the Company has estimated an increase in provision for employee benefits, on account of the New Labour Codes, by Rs. 46.34 Lakhs and the same has been recognized under the head 'Employee benefits expense' in the statement of profit and loss for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2025. The Company continues to monitor developments and will review its estimates on the finalisation of Central / State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the New Labour Codes and will provide appropriate accounting effect on the basis of such developments as needed.
- 10 Figures of the previous periods have been regrouped, wherever necessary, to make them comparable with the current period.

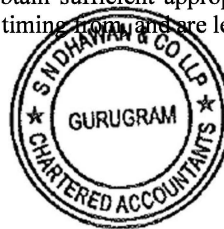
1. This certificate is issued in accordance with the terms of our engagement letter dated 08 July 2025.

The accompanying Statement is initialled by us for identification purpose only.

Management's responsibility

3. The accompanying Statement, including the creation and maintenance of all accounting and other records supporting its contents, is solely the responsibility of the Management of the Company. The Company's Management is responsible for the designing, implementing, and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement, and applying an appropriate basis of preparation; and making estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.
4. The Company's Management is also responsible for ensuring that the Company complies with all the relevant requirements of the SEBI Regulations and for providing all relevant information to the Debenture Trustee and for complying with all the covenants as prescribed in the Debenture Trust Deed.

Auditor's responsibility

5. Our responsibility is to provide limited assurance with respect to the book values of the assets as on 31 December 2025 assigned against the listed non-convertible debt securities.
6. We have reviewed the financial results for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2025, prepared by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, and issued an unmodified Conclusion dated 03 February 2026. Our review of these financial results for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2025 was conducted in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") respectively.
7. We conducted our examination of the Statement in accordance with the Guidance Note on Reports or Certificates for Special Purposes issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The Guidance Note requires that we comply with the ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
8. We have complied with the relevant applicable requirements of the Standard on Quality Control (SQC) 1, Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Reviews of Historical Financial Information, and Other Assurance and Related Service Engagements.
